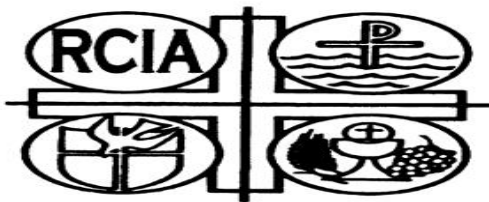

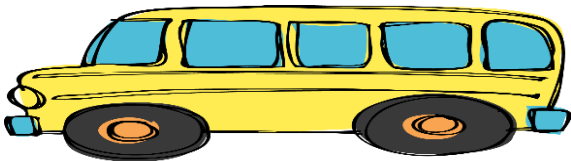

~LENTEN MINI-RETREATS~

Lent is a time for us to pause and to make extra time for prayer, penance and reflection. To assist us on this journey, The Cathedral of St. Eugene, 2323 Montgomery Drive, Santa Rosa, is offering 4 mini-retreats on 4 consecutive Saturdays during Lent: February 24th, March 3rd, 10th and 17th. We begin with Fr. James Zakowicz, from the Carmelite Monastery in Oakville, whose topic will be: *The Return of the Prodigal – Repentance and Forgiveness*. The following Saturday, Fr. David Jenuwine, from St. Apollinaris Church in Napa, will speak on: *The Nuts and Bolts of Confession*. Then, Fr. Gary Sumpter, from St. Thomas Aquinas church in Napa, will speak on: *Sharing in the Passion and Resurrection of Christ*. Our final speaker will be Fr.
